Believe it or not, I can't type some letters in the standard Find or Replace dialogs (Ctrl-Shift-F/R). Most letters work, but certain capital letters just...don't...do anything.

For instance, if I hold down the shift key and type the alphabet, this is what I get:
AGHIJLNQTUVXYZ

I'm on OSX Leopard, 10.5.6.
