(yes, I know previously cache clearing didn't help, but now with the fix

it helped at least several people).

But there seems to be a collision between some values:

VS: User Types, User Types (Delegates, Enums, Interfaces, Type Parameters, Value Types)

and

Fonts and Colors

R#: Type Identifier

After a reload of VS the values are mixed up on the screen.

But if you set one to Automatic (not to Default!) and the other to a defined value it seems to work, somehow.

I am not getting the R# items in Fonts & colors.

I tried clearing the cache (I renamed it) and restarting VS but it made no difference.

Should I uninstall 5, install 4.5 then reinstall 5?
