Hi again,

one more thing I noticed for some time now...

I have a list of commands like this:

```
if(cond1) return true;
```

```
if(cond2) return true;
```

```
if(cond3) return true;
```

```
if(cond4) return true;
```

```
return false;
```

with comments in between. I know this could be converted to:

```
return cond1 || cond2 || ...;
```

But because of the comments I would like to keep things as they are.

R# now tries to convert it to:

```
if(cond1) return true;
```

Ignore not working

```
if(cond2) return true;
```

```
if(cond3) return true;
```

```
return cond4;
```

I don't want it to do this in this special case, so I used the disable

comment:

```
// ReSharper disable ConvertIfStatementToReturnStatement
```

```
if(cond4) {
```

```
    // ReSharper restore ConvertIfStatementToReturnStatement
```

```
    return true;
```

```
}
```

```
return false;
```

R# ignores this, though, and still wants to convert the if statement.

The comments were generated by R#, so either R# creates false comments

or it does not understand its own comments 😊
